Product:

Totally Care – Floor Cleaner.

General:

TCFC is a unique cleaning agent made of natural compounds to provide cleaning properties unlike common detergents. It is free from bases & phosphates and in addition to this contains no gloss agents, waxes or polymers. This means treated surfaces are free of any film or topical residue commonly associated with conventional cleaning agents which normally result in surfaces attracting dirt and residue at a more accelerated rate.

Properties:

- Biodegradable.
- Highly concentrated.
- Easy to use.
- Water soluble.
- Non-toxic.

Range of applications:

TCFC is suitable for (but not limited to) use on the following materials. It does not matter whether surfaces are smooth or rough, sealed, glazed, treated or untreated:

- Concrete.
- Stone.
- Slate.
- Terrazzo.
- Engineered Stone.
- Vinyl flooring.
- Timber flooring.
- Epoxy coated / painted floors.

Mixing:

For every 10L of water, add 20-40ml (2-4 table spoons) of Totally Care

Application Instructions:

Wipe / mop surfaces with diluted product and allow to dry.

Storage:

Store in original packaging with lid well sealed. Keep in cool to warm environment and do not allow to freeze.

Shelf Life:

Approximately 2 year if kept stored according to above.
